


Hall Lake – Survey Response Summary

Respondents Gender:




What do you like most about your community?


Which cultural events/programs/services would you like to see in your community?



How effective are emergency services in your community?




What are your concerns with emergency services in your community?


Respondents Highest Level of Education:

Are there barriers or problems to acquiring training or employment?


- No jobs available in the community






